| | Jewish Lvov tour | Old and new Jewish Quarter of the City, remains of the former main synagoge "Golden Rose", Memorial for the Jewish Victims of the WWII, the former Jewish hospital, the former home of Scholom Alejchem, former Yanovsky concentration camp site |

| | General Lvov sightseeing | 3-4 hr; Ancient & modern Lvov, including Market square, Dormition cathedral; Dominican catholic church, brewery museum, the High Castle (the highest spot in Lvov with the breathtaking view), etc. |

| | Kolomyia sightseeing | Holocaust memorial; old and new synagogues, old city streets, the only world museum of Pysanka (Easter Eggs, over 6000 exhibits) |

| | Jewish Chernovtsy sightseeing | Synagogue "Beit-Tfilah", area of WWII Ghetto, Turkish well, Mikveh, Tailor's Club "Schneiderferrerin", historical Chernovtsy down-town, Gross Schil ("A Large Synagogue"), other synagogues; Museum of Jewish Bukovina Heritage (large number of exhibits XVIII-XX, including ancient books, documents, religious artifacts, household utensils, etc.) |

| | Jewish Chernovtsy sightseeing cont'd | Jewish cemetery on Green Street (Zelenaya ulitsa): One of the largest Jewish cemeteries in Europe (over 14 hectares, 137 separate quarters, over 100 000 graves, some of them are of famous and prominent Jews); the graveside (Ravinergof) of Ruzhiner Rebbe Yisrael Friedman in Sadgora |
